

COMPLYING WITH NC IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR COLLEGE ENTRY

NOTE TO STUDENT: North Carolina law requires proof of certain immunizations for college entry. The purpose of these requirements is to prevent the spread of certain communicable diseases on campus. Students who are taking night, weekend, extension, or online courses **ONLY** are **EXEMPT** from these requirements.

Please select the proper age category below and note the required immunizations. Review your childhood immunization record to determine if you have the correct type and number of vaccinations. (If you have 2 MMR shots, or 1 Measles shot and 1 MMR, this covers the requirement for Measles, Mumps, and Rubella). Regardless of your age, you must have had the initial series of DTP shots as a child and one tetanus shot within the past 10 years.

If you are lacking any required immunizations, or do not have a record of immunizations you have received, take this sheet to your physician or local health department and ask them to administer any needed immunizations that are age-appropriate. Please present proof of immunizations to the Admissions Office with your application packet, or as soon thereafter as possible.

Footnote⁴ - One dose on or after 12 months of age.
